The proposed Padovan Landscape Alliance would be a nonprotit organization formed for the purpose of facilitating the development of the redesigned Roncajette Park. This Alliance would be a new public entity with responsibilities including fundraising, marketing and public outreach, programming, advocacy, organization of local volunteers, and establishing security, management, and maintenance associated with the new park.

The Alliance's unique structure would be that of a public organization with associated private affiliates and the major stockholder would be the Comune di Padova. The Padovan Landscape Alliance would be established with the directive of overseeing the planning, construction, and management of the new public park project. The process of developing such an alliance has the potential to create both economic and social synergies.

Additionally, the redevelopment strategy of Roncajette Park could be a model for future park development elsewhere in the region, for which the Alliance could potentially expand its role. Thus Roncajette Park would become a catalyst for both an integrated city-wide park system and a broad regional park system.

URBAN TRANSFORMATION

To provide for the transformation of urban areas through development and redevelopment of parks, industrial zones, recreational facilities, open spaces, streetscapes, and transportation systems for the benefit and enjoyment of Padova's residents, visitors, and wildlife.

MAINTENANCE


To assist in the maintenance of parks, open spaces, recreation facilities, plazas, and streetscapes through practical, economic, and collaborative means to achieve clean, safe, attractive, and inviting spaces.

PARTICIPATION

To promote and strengthen the participation of government, public and private institutions, and the regional community in the planning, development, management, and stewardship of public residential, commercial, and industrial parks.

FUNDING

To build and improve financial and other resources to adequately develop and maintain the quality, quantity, and equitable provision of parks, open spaces, recreation facilities, streetscapes, and sustainable industrial areas.
